RE: Adoption of Ten-Year Plan to Reduce Homelessness in Chelan and Douglas Counties

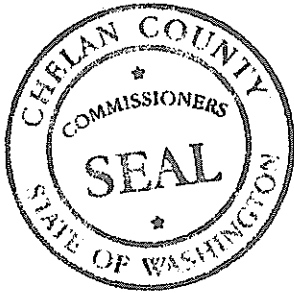
WHEREAS, HB 2163 assigns Chelan County and the Department of Community, Trade, and Economic Development, (DCTED) with ending homelessness within ten years,
